EarthShare Georgia, founded in 1992, connects people to trusted Nonprofit Partners dedicated to conserving and protecting our air, land and water. EarthShare Georgia raises funds primarily through workplace giving partnerships with more than 50 employers that help support more than 70 environmental and conservation organizations. Approximately 30 of these organizations are based in Georgia, the others are national Nonprofit Partners - some of which have offices or have field representatives in Georgia.
